



The Jury Committee shall be appointed by the GCAA executive board and shall remain anonymous. The decisions of the jury are final.

In the event that an applicant for Exhibiting Artist status does not meet the criteria required by the Jury Committee, the artist may submit work again for the jury process six (6) months from the date of the first jury process.

Exhibiting artists wishing to exhibit work in a medium for which they have not been juried will be asked to submit such work for jurying before it can be exhibited.

The GCAA Gallery will contact submitting artists within two weeks of application to inform the artist of the jury's decision. If accepted into the gallery, the GCAA will arrange a meeting with the artist at a mutually agreeable time, to complete business arrangements and acquaint you with the gallery's operation.

If a vacancy is not available, you may become a Gallery Artist Member Elect and your name will be added to the waiting list. You will be contacted as soon as a vacancy is available for installation of your work.
